Guest Speaker . . .

The Right Reverend STEPHEN THOMAS (Bishop of Llandaff)



The Bishop of Llandaff, the Right Reverend Stephen Thomas, was educated at Rossall School, Anglesey; St. John's College, Oxford; and Wells Theological College.

He was ordained at St. Asaph Cathedral in 1933 and after serving as curate at Colwyn Bay and at Hawarden, he became vicar of Risca in the diocese of Monmouth in 1943.

He was invited to become Warden of Saint Michael's Theological College in the diocese of Llandaff in 1948, and he held this appointment for six years.

In 1954 he became Dean and Vicar of Llandaff and he was responsible for the restoration of Llandaff Cathedral, where a service of Thanksgiving was held on the 6th August, 1960, in the presence of the Queen and the Duke of Edinburgh.

He was elected and consecrated Bishop of Monmouth in St. Asaph Cathedral in March, 1968, and was translated to Llandaff in 1971 where on 11th December, he was enthroned at Llandaff Cathedral.

The Bishop takes a keen interest in industrial life and established the Glamorgan Industrial Mission.

A former pupil of Afon Taf High School and The Merthyr Tydfil College of Further Education, Wayne joined the company in September, 1969.

He is at present in his final year of training as an electrician, and is following the Electrical Installation Course at the Merthyr College of Further Education.

Wayne was elected chairman of the Apprentice Association during the third year of his apprenticeship, and took a leading part in organising the 1972 Charity Event. The event was an outstanding success and raised £925 for the Merthyr Society for Mentally Handicapped Children.
